MUA Sustainability Audit

On Sunday 12th January after the service we will be holding a session for the MUA Sustainability Audit. Rev Mark Hutchinson will be joining us and would like to speak to as many of the congregation as possible. Please join us if you can.

The audit aims to assess the current position of each congregation around aspects of resources and programs. It aims to also review congregations' hopes for the future and aid them in drawing out areas of possibilities, mapping future needs.

The aim of the Sustainability Audit is to aid congregations in their decision-making process. It will also facilitate the work of the MUA to meet their objectives of offering support, advice, funding and training, where appropriate, for all the congregations of the MUA. This audit will enable each individual congregation to assess their needs going forward. But it will also allow for an accumulation of congregational information. This can then help the MUA meet their objectives of assessing the support and aid requirements. It can also help towards assessing any potential collaborative ministry that can assist the development of Unitarianism in the Midlands.
